About the Workshop:

This three-day hands-on workshop is appropriate for Photoshop users of all levels who use this application for work in many areas in forensics, including crime scene photography, latent print examination, and forensic video analysis. It covers information, techniques, and includes exercises that can be learned by beginners and can also be challenging for experienced Photoshop users.

Topics include digital imaging theory, court issues, the digital imaging workflow, color and tonal adjustments, creating panoramas and high dynamic range images, latent print enhancement, photographic on-screen comparison, working with security and surveillance video in Photoshop, and creating court charts.

The participant will learn the following concepts, techniques, and skills:

- Basic Digital Imaging Theory
- Appropriate File Formats in Forensic Digital Imaging
- Best Practices for a Forensic Digital Imaging Workflow
- Court Issues in Forensic Digital Imaging
- Sizing Images 1:1
- Latent Print Enhancement
- Working with video in Photoshop
- On-Screen Comparisons (fingerprint, video, photographs, etc.)
- Creating Court Charts

This workshop is presented as a combination of lectures, discussions, and hands-on exercises.
